KV00CG83 Russian 1, 3 ects

Objectives:

Students are able to

- read, write and understand Cyrillic alphabets
- read and write short phrases in Russian
- introduce themselves and their family orally and in writing
- use simple expressions in everyday communication

Proficiency level: A1.1

Contents:

Situations: presentation, profession, ordering food in a cafe, greetings and farewells, orientation in the city, the days of the week, time of the day.

Grammar: affirmative, negative and question phrases in present, nouns gender, possessive pronouns, Present tenses of verbs, grammar cases (nominative and prepositional), numerals.

Teaching methods:

Language of instructions: Finnish, English and Russian.

<u>Blended learning</u>: participating in lectures, online assignments and homeworks, speaking tasks, accepted obligatory tasks. The lessons are taught two times in a week for two hours at once or once a week for four hours at once. 70% active participation in class.

<u>Online learning</u>: participating in on-line lectures, speaking tasks and accepted obligatory tasks. Online attendance is obligatory. Online lessons are taught once a week.

Evaluation:

KV00CG84 Russian 2, 3 ects

Objectives:

Students are able to

- expand the vocabulary used in everyday situations
- use the basic Russian grammatical structures in everyday situations
- communicate clearly
- apply different features of Russian culture in various communicative situations.

Proficiency level: A1.2

Contents:

Situations: in a hotel, café or restaurant, shopping, customs procedures in train, hire a taxi, on the phone, talking about yourself, your family and free time.

Grammar: singular and plural adjectives in Nominative case, plural nouns in Nominative case, Present tenses of verbs, Accusative case, numerals up to 1000.

Teaching methods:

Language of instructions: Finnish, English and Russian.

<u>Blended learning</u>: participating in lectures, online assignments and homeworks, speaking tasks, accepted obligatory tasks. The lessons are taught two times in a week for two hours at once or once a week for four hours at once. 70% active participation in class.

<u>Online learning</u>: participating in on-line lectures, speaking tasks and accepted obligatory tasks. Online attendance is obligatory. Online lessons are taught once a week.

Objectives:

- write simple messages

Proficiency level: A1.3

Contents:

Situations: on a business trip, company visit, asking directions, expressing dates, writing emails, working with clients and hobbies.

Grammar: motion verbs, ordinal numbers 1-31, Genitive and Instrumental cases, Past tense of verbs, reflexive verbs and Complex Future tense.

Teaching methods:

Language of instructions: Finnish, English and Russian.

Blended learning: participating in lectures, online assignments and homeworks, speaking tasks, accepted obligatory tasks. The lessons are taught two times in a week for two hours at once or once a week for four hours at once. 70% active participation in class.

Teaching material:

Materials provided by the lecturer on Moodle.

Evaluation:

Grammar: Dative case, modal verbs, verbs aspect, nouns and adjectives plural forms in different cases.

Teaching methods:

Language of instructions: Finnish, English and Russian.

Blended learning: participating in lectures, online assignments and homeworks, speaking tasks, accepted obligatory tasks. The lessons are taught two times in a week for two hours at once or once a week for four hours at once. 70 % active participation in class.

Teaching material:

Materials provided by the lecturer on Moodle.

Evaluation:

Grammar: structures typical of business communication, expressing time, cases of nouns and adjectives in singular and plural, verbs' tenses, aspects.

Teaching methods:

Language of instructions: Finnish, English and Russian. Online learning: participating in online lectures, speaking tasks and accepted obligatory assignments.
