



Quick statistics

- Total of 971 answers to the survey
- 66% Bachelor's and 32% Master's students. 2% were exchange students.
- The OLS survey is repeating every year, so for the most parts it was similar to the 2021 and 2022 survey for easy comparison
- LUT and especially programmes use data in the coming fall
- There were lots of written feedback!
- Overall very similar results compared to last year



Load of studies, speed and motivation (1 / 2)



Load of studies, speed and motivation (2 / 2)




- Results are similar to last year

- Average score of study motivation was 2,8 (1 = very bad, 4 = very good)
 - Last year the average score was 2,9.


Diggin in to details: factors that affect studies

- Wellbeing in general and mental condition plays a major role

 Ongoing students mental health crisis is
 - showing results in this survey
 - Last year the average score of mental condition affecting the pace of studies was 2,6.

 Also lack if motivation is affecting the studies







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The lack of communality

- We wanted to ask about students' experiences related to communality, as well as its effects on study motivation
- Many answers said that the feeling of communality is weak. The corona pandemic has greatly affected the feeling of communality.

(As a corona-time fresher, grouping with other people was more difficult than normal, as a result of which the circle of friends remained quite small)



 Teaching skills is the biggest one


 Also the lack of course material affects the studies (for example lack of proper Moodle material)

Diggin in to details: factors that slow studies(2/2)

- Courses feel overburdening and studies feel unevenly distributed
- Also the two-tier system slows the studies
 - Lots of open feedback considering two-tier system -> system is slowing down the studies of many students
- Last year, the average for the affect of exchange studies was 1,4. The score is higher this year, 1,6.



15. How much do the following factors about study environment affect your studies (1 = does not affect at all, 4 = affects very negatively):





- Higher = better So good results with average of 2,8 Students are overall happy with LUTs environment and culture
 - Some negative feedback considering course feedback -> students feel that the feedback is not utilized enough, and the courses do not improve despite the feedback









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Academic fraud in LUT (2/2)

Mielestäni on totta, että moodle-tentit tekevät vilpin helpoksi, koska vaikka ulkopuolisten materiaalien käyttö kiellettäisiin, ei sitä kukaan pysty valvoa. Moodletentit olisi ehkä järkevintä tehdä sellaisiksi että saa tehdä materiaalien kanssa, mutta on esim. Aikaraja ja materiaaleista ei ole hyötyä, jos ei osaa ennakkoon.

Moodle-tenteissä vilpillinen menettely on valitettavasti liian helppoa ja yleistä. Toisaalta, Moodle tenttejäkin voidaan rakentaa siten, että tentti testaa ymmärrystä kokonaisvaltaisesti eikä vain kysy nippelitietoa kurssimateriaalista, jonka helposti tenttiä tehdessä voi tarkistaa.

Muissa tenteissä vilpillisyys on haastavampaa eikä niinkään muiden opiskelijoiden silmissä hyväksyttävämpää

Ennen digitalisaation integroitumista opintoihin, oli helpompaa määritellä mitä vilppi on. Mitä se nykyään on? Mielestäni kurssien arvosteluinstrumentit (kokeet, harjoitustyöt, kotitehtävät...) tulee suunnitella niin, ettei "vilpistä" mitä se ikinä onkaan ole hyötyä niiden tekemisessä.

Joskus harmittaa, kun tuntuu että osa opiskelijoista turvautuu vilpillisiin keinoihin opinnoissaan ja saa hyviä arvosanoja. Kuitenkin, tiedän että oma moraalini ei sallisi vilppiä enkä kokisi saatuja suorituksia ansaituksi mikäli itse hankkisin ne vilpin keinoin. Muiden vilppiin on kuitenkin hankala puuttua.


Mielestäni etäopiskelu on ajanut opiskelijat liian helposti huijaamaan moodletenteitssä. Varsinkin kun useat opettajat eivät ole muuttaneet tenttejä juurikaan, joten vastaukset löytyvät suoraan materiaaleista. Joka ei juuri parantanut motia opiskella.

Diggin in to details: easing the workload


19. How much do the following factors ease / would ease your studies? (1 = not at all, 4 = a lot)

- Two-tier system is not motivating at all






Diggin in to details: study related factors at LUT



- Lecture recordings, remote lectures and Moodle exams are very praised among students!



Diggin in to details: working and studying

- 45% work and 55% don't in addition of studying
 Last year 49% of the students worked
- Some students need more guidance and tools considering career goals
- Some feedback hoping more individual jobseeking guidance





TL-DR

- Wellbeing and mental conditions play a major role in studies and in motivation considering studying
- Two-tier system is still causing issues
- Academic fraud is an issue in LUT -> change of attitudes and course implementations are in place
- Data will be analyzed better later this year by larger group of people









SITUATION AT THE TIME OF GRADUATION, SHARE OF EMPLOYED




Employment rate has mainly developed in good direction.

LEVEL OF DEMAND IN JOB CORRESPONDING WITH LUT University **EDUCATION**






Quality of employment is equally strong on Finnish and international students.

Quality of employment declined in 2021, in 2022 it has started to increase.



- >>> 58 % in large companies and 23 % for SMEs






Importance of knowledge and skills in current job TOP 10 – LUT












Response rate, LUT course feedback 2018-2021




COURSES BELOW LUT QUALITY STANDARD




Quality indicator of courses: The course as a whole promoted my learning (scale 1= very little, 5= very much).

- LUT average has been 3.8 on 1. and 2. period 2022-23 (variation between degree programmes was 3.6 4.1)
- The minimum target level of mean is 3.3 and course feedback below the target level requires actions to be taken in the degree programme.






NEW FEATURE - N TARGET - IN PRACTISE
