# KF00CH30 French 1, 3 ECTS

## **Objectives:**

After completing the course, the student is able to

- use the basic structures and vocabulary necessary for work and study life introductory situations
- present oneself orally and in writing.

Proficiency level: A1.1.

#### **Contents:**

Pronunciation, introduction, self-expression, basic differences between formal and informal communication, asking questions, expressing preferences.

Structures: Verbs present tense forms, articles, prepositions, personal pronouns, structure expressing ownership, prohibition, questions, numbers 0-69.

### **Learning material:**

Texts and exercises in Moodle

#### **Teaching methods:**

Participating in contact lectures, individual assignments, oral exercises.

### **Evaluation:**

Written and spoken test. The grade given on basis of the continuous evaluation that requires 75% of active presence. Scale 0-5.

# KF00CH31 French 2, 3 ECTS

### **Objectives:**

After completing the course, the student is able to

- use the basic structures and vocabulary necessary in work and study life situations, and to tell about his/her use of time and daily routines.
- communicate in travel situations
- tell about working / study day routines

Proficiency level: A1.2.

#### **Contents:**

Telling time, telling about one's day; travelling (vehicles); communication by phone and email.

Structures: articles, question words, demonstrative adjectives and pronouns, prepositions à, de, en, present tense, reflexive verbs, near future, numbers 70-1000.

## **Teaching methods:**

Contact lessons, individual assignments, oral exercises.

#### **Evaluation:**

Written and spoken test. The grade given on basis of the continuous evaluation that requires 75% of active presence. Scale 0-5.

# KF00CH32 French 3, 3 ECTS

### **Objectives:**

- tell about eating habits and order at a restaurant
- tell about past events
- describe the appearance of people and things and compare things
- tell the difference between the formal and informal communication

Proficiency level: A1.3.

## **Contents:**

Ordering at the restaurant; the meals of the day; telling about the past events; describing persons and things

Structures: articles, adjectives, comparison of adjectives, prepositions, personal pronouns, present, passé composé, partitive, quantitative expressions, numerals 1000 -, ordinary numbers.

#### **Evaluation:**
