



# **EchoVideo – Lecture Capture**

### What is EchoVideo (earlier Echo360)

- A lecture capture system for the teachers to publish videos and live stream
- Consists of several elements:
  - Lecture capture devices in lecture rooms
  - Capture program for teachers for short video making
  - Echo course page in for publishing videos -> connected to Moodle
  - Video library (for teachers)
- Students can use learning tools depending on the sharing (on Echo courses)





### How to make the most of lecture recordings

- In the first place, go to lectures and take notes
- Watch lecture capture and complete your notes, if you did not catch all.
- If you missed the lecture, watch the capture fully and take notes. For recap you can use double speed. Watch the capture before the next lecture
- Ask lecturer if you did not understand something by using Question function or Flag (see instructions later) if not face-to-face.
- Don't leave watching until last day before the exam. Look at other material first to recap.

- If EchoVideo is used for publishing lecture videos, you can access to them:
  - Direct <u>URL-link</u> (public)



Or <u>Echo link</u> with videos and presentations,




- redirects to Echo course page or single video

### Viewing the video via URL link


Open the video by clicking the link.








### Viewing the video via Echo link








#### **Classroom tools**


- Echo-videon opiskelijan toiminnot
  - 1. Notes: write *notes* during watching
  - 2. Questions & Answers (Q&A): Discussion panel for asking and responding to questions. Also anonymous posting
  - 3. Bookmarks: Save bookmarks during watching
  - 4. Flag: use flagging to point out *confusion* in the material
















## Q & A (Discussion panel)








### Flag confusion
