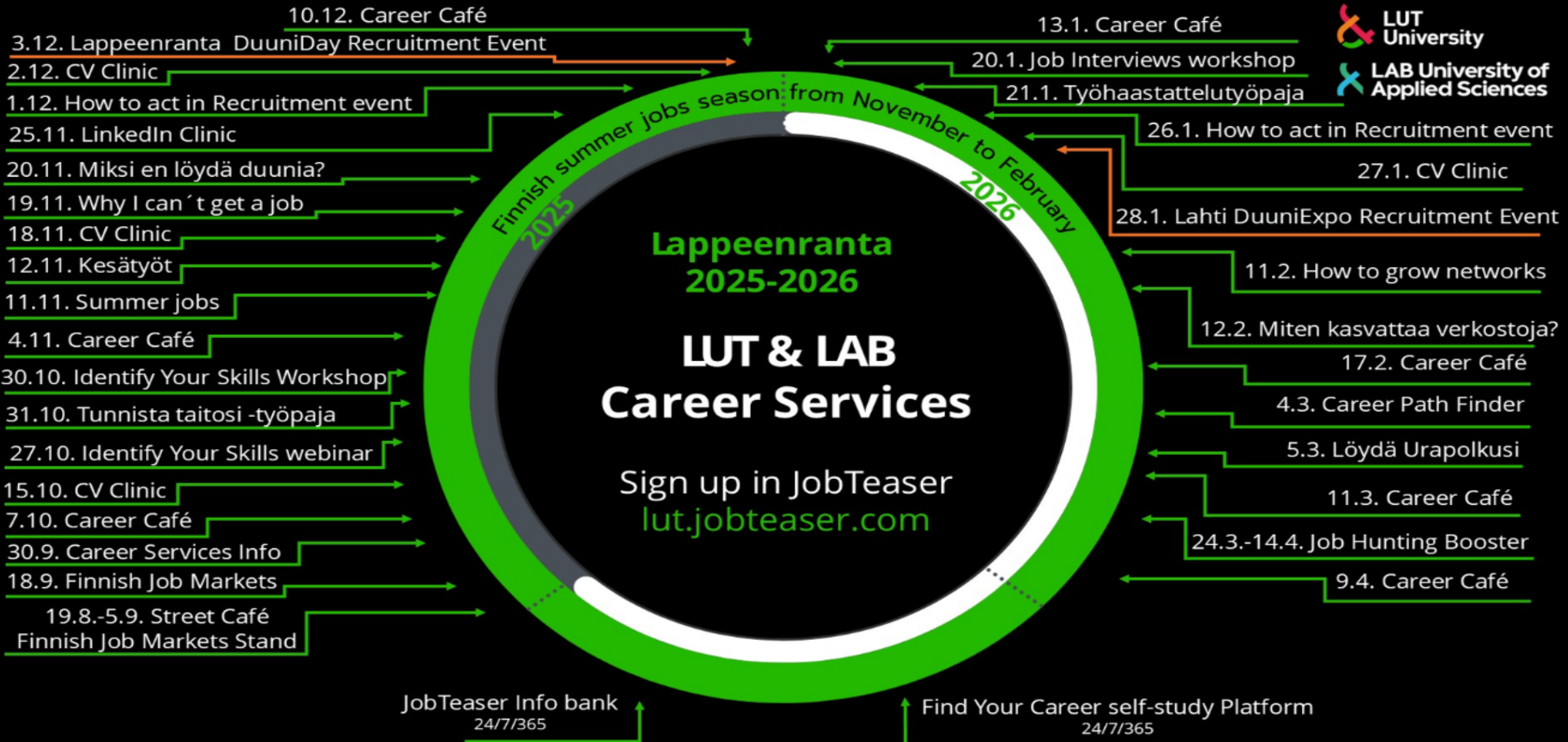

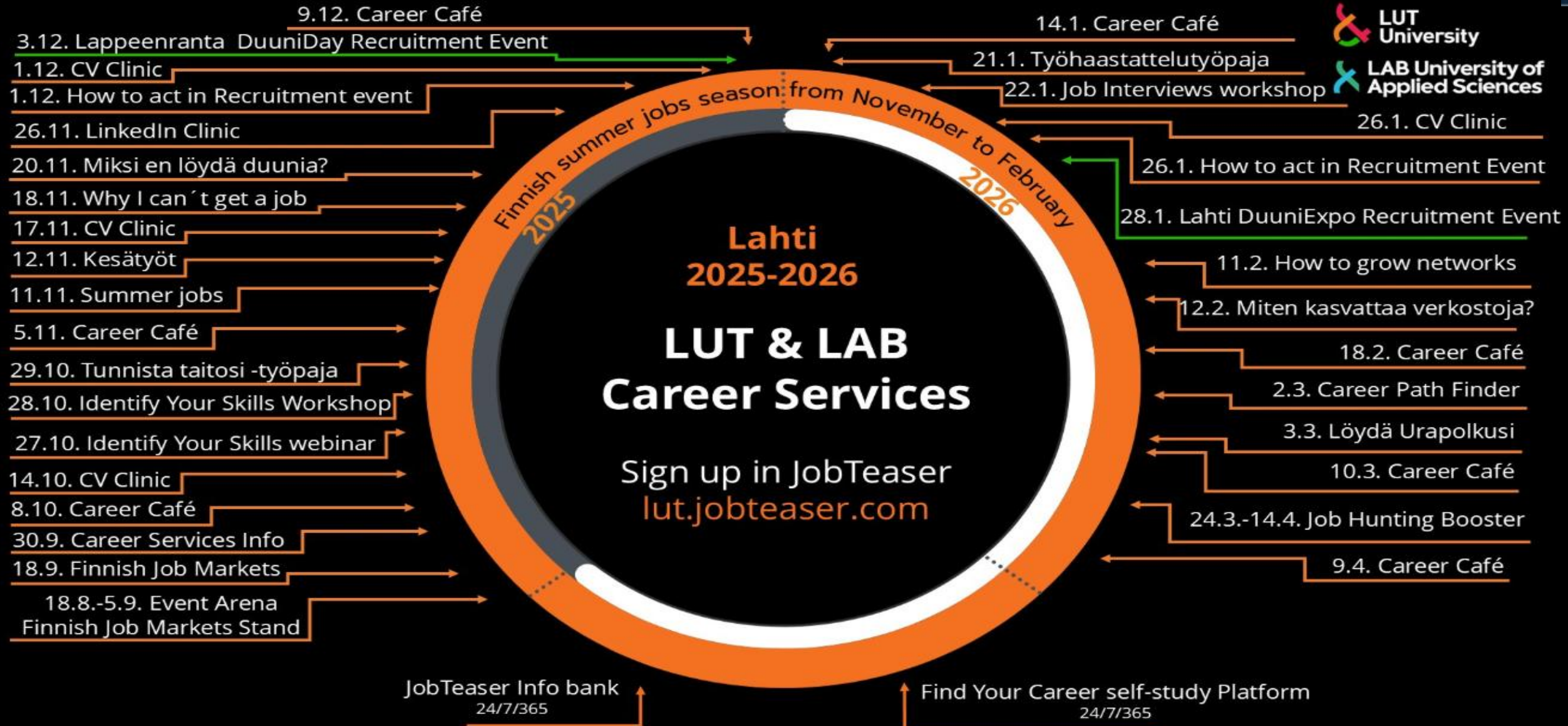

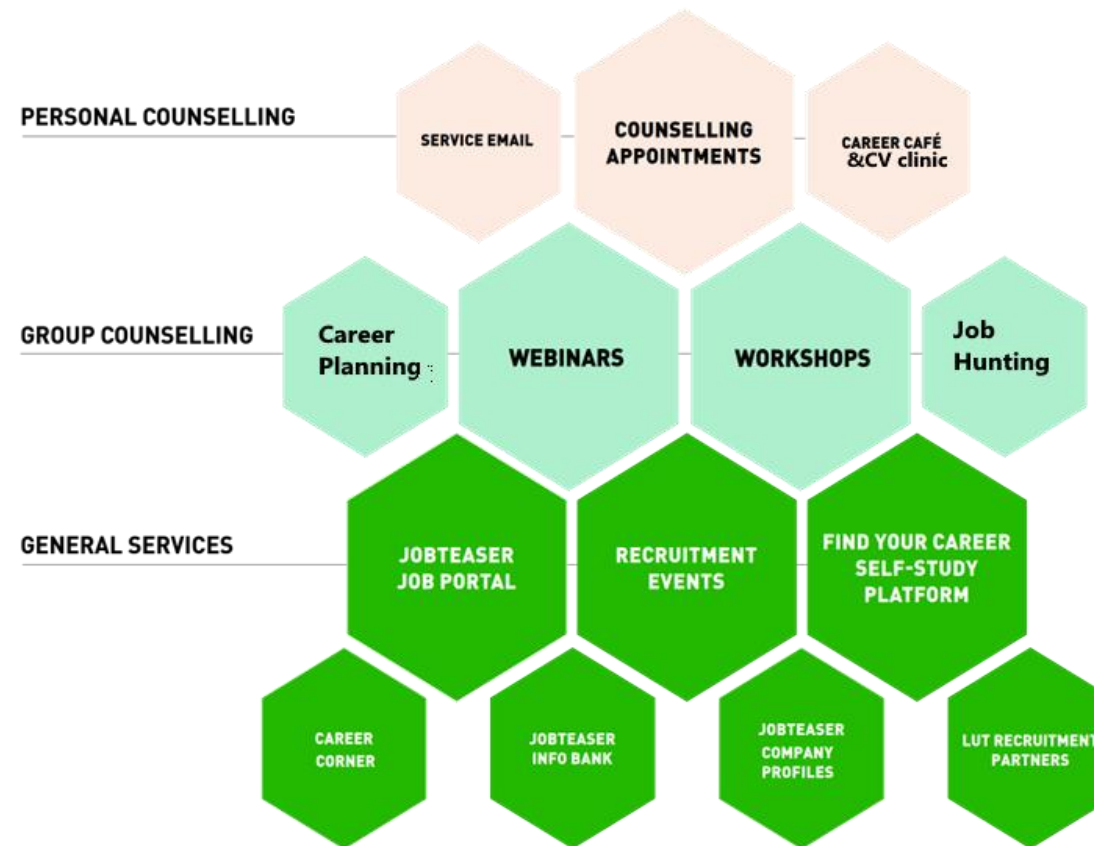

Top 10 advices at this stage:

1. Start Fresh and Stay Curious

This is a new chapter, explore different opportunities with an open mind. You don't need to have everything figured out right away.

2. Have Plans A, B, and C

8. Make the Most of Summer Jobs

Summer jobs are not just a paycheck they're a chance to build networks, gain experience, and strengthen your CV.

9. Value All Types of Work

Every job teaches you something — teamwork, problem-solving, customer service — and employers value these transferable skills.

10. Learn from Alumni
