ENKLAAVI'S COMMITTEES

In addition to Enklaavi's board, the core of its activities revolves around seven committees, each responsible for a specific area of the association's operations. Each committee is led by one or more board members, and new members are recruited annually after the board changes.

HARASSMENT CONTACT PERSONS (HCPS)

Harassment contact personnel are here to offer support to students based on the principle of low-threshold accessibility. You can also reach out if you feel stressed or anxious about your studies or if something else is weighing on your mind.

Additionally, you can contact us if you are concerned about inappropriate behavior directed at someone else. It is important to remember that your feelings are always valid, and you can talk to us with confidence.

All conversations with us are strictly confidential, and we operate under a duty of confidentiality. We respect the principles of a safer space and will not take any action without your consent. We will support you for as long as needed and help you consider the best ways to address the situation. You can be assured that making a report does not automatically trigger further actions. Feel free to come to us as you are, without fear of being judged. We act impartially and carefully listen to all parties involved, especially in situations where multiple people are affected.

You can contact us via email (hairinta@enklaavi.fi), the reporting form, Instagram, phone, or in person at the university. We are often present at Enklaavi's events, and you are always welcome to come and talk to us. At events, there may also be designated support persons who operate under the same confidentiality principles. If you prefer, you can send a message anonymously through the reporting form. If you wish your message to reach only a specific harassment support person, please mention this clearly in your message.

BECOME A MEMBER

To become part of Enklaavi, you must join Suomen Ekonomit as a student member.

HERE'S HOW TO JOIN:

All students studying at the LUT Business School are eligible to become student members of Suomen Ekonomit. By joining Suomen Ekonomit, you also become a member of your own student association, which in Lappeenranta is Enklaavi ry.

Membership with Suomen Ekonomit is free of charge. When you join, Suomen Ekonomit will only charge you the Enklaavi ry membership fee, which will be forwarded to your student association. Enklaavi's membership fee is €35, covering your entire study period. As an Enklaavi member, you'll receive information about neon yellow overalls and membership benefits. Additionally, you can spend time at Enklaavi's guild room. As proof of your membership, you'll receive an electronic membership card from both Suomen Ekonomit and Enklaavi.

Mikä on **Enklaavi**

Enklaavi ry on Lappeenrannan teknillisen yliopiston kauppatieteiden opiskelijoiden kasvava ja dynaaminen ainejärjestö. Vuodesta 1991 asti toiminut ainejärjestömme on noussut LUT:n suurimmaksi ja aktiivisimmaksi killaksi. Tällä hetkellä Enklaavilla on noin 1700 jäsentä.

Enklaavi tarkoittaa hallinnollista aluetta, joka on toisen vastaavan hallinnollisen alueen ympäröimänä. LUT-yliopisto sijaitsee Lappeenrannassa Skinnarilan kaupunginosassa, joka opiskelijoiden keskuudessa nimetty SVV:ksi eli Skinnarilan Vapaa Valtioksi. Skinnarila on huhujen mukaan hakenut itsenäisyyttä Suomen valtiosta, jolloin siitä olisi muodostunut Enklaavi.

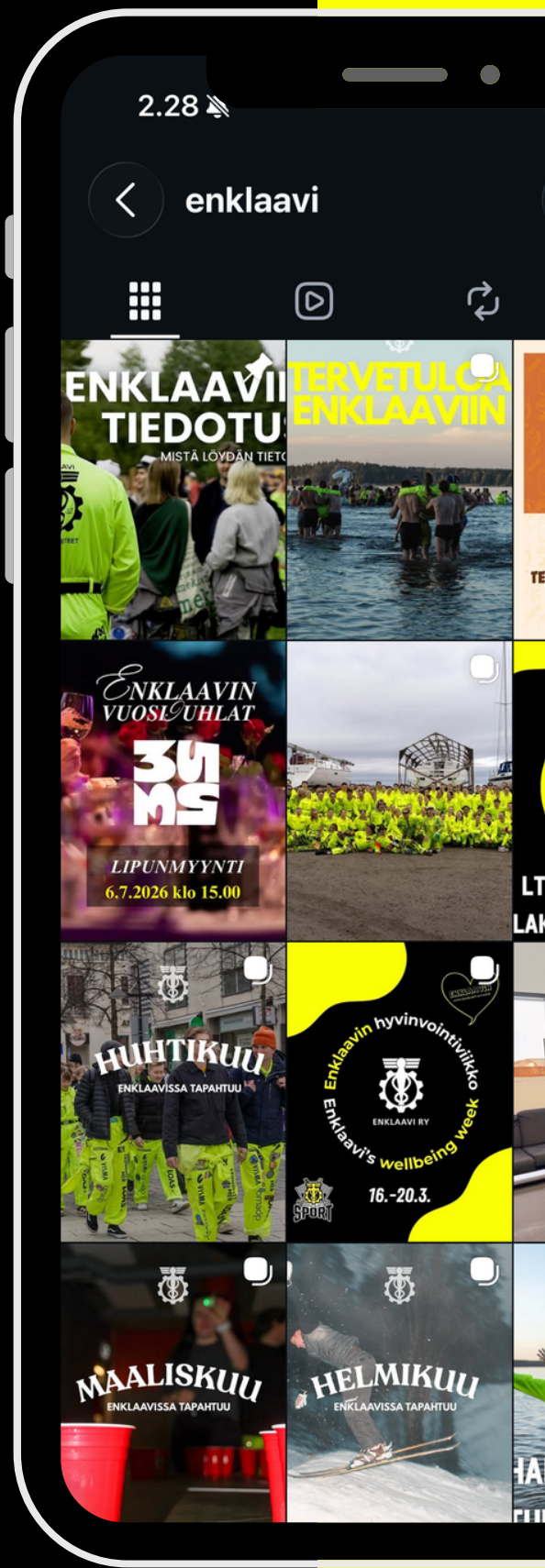

TUUDO

Tuudo is a personal helper for students' academic life. By using a single app, students can view their class schedule, register for courses, navigate the campus, visit the library, and check the menus of student cafeterias.

KUUTTI

[Enklaavi's fresher] ; KUUTTI

An Enklaavi fresher is a first-year student at LUT University's Business School. The term is used during the fresher weeks for all first-year students of Enklaavi before they are officially inducted as kylterifreshers during the promotion ceremony. Kuutti is the Finnish term for a baby seal, or a seal pup.

In Lahti you can study Energy Technology (**Fuusio**), Industrial Engineering and Management (**Kapital**) and Software Engineering (**SoSA**). LAB University of Applied Sciences also have their own student organizations.

DICTIONARY

- AALEF:** LTKY's (the student union) own company includes for example the restaurant YOLO located on the university campus, as well as Meidän Kioski, in the university lobby.
- Academic quarter:** The "academic quarter" is a tradition used in universities, according to which lectures, for example, start 15 minutes past the hour. If it is not specifically stated that a lecture begins on the hour, you can assume that the academic quarter is in effect.
- Appros:** A student event where the goal is to visit local bars, restaurants, or similar venues and collect stamps, which eventually earn you an overall badge.
- Kuutti/Fuksi:** First year student, aka fresher.
- Kylteri:** A senior business student. Freshers become 'kylteris' during the spring fresher baptism in the warm embrace of Lake Saimaa.
- G-bar/Gee:** Cafe Bar G, a bar located behind the Student Union Building.
- eLUT:** An important online information bank for students, where you can find comprehensive information about completing studies at LUT University.
- Excursion/Excu:** A study trip to almost anywhere. The trip may include, for example, company visits, other activities, and hanging out with fellow students.
- LTKY/Iytty:** The Student Union of LUT University. The advocate for university students, ensuring that everyone enjoys university life to the fullest.
- Moodle:** A virtual learning environment used at the university, where each course has its own page containing all the necessary information for completing the course.
- NESU:** Derived from the words Nordiska Ekonomie Studerandes Union. It connects Nordic business students. In Finland, NESU associations organize events such as sitsit in various cities.

PRACTICAL STUFF



APPLY FOR BENEFITS FROM KELA AND SUBMIT A CHANGE OF ADDRESS NOTIFICATION (ONLY FOR FINNISH CITIZENS OR PERMANENT RESIDENTS)

Kela benefits are applied for through OmaKela, and the easiest way to submit a change of address is through the Posti website, which updates the information both to Posti and DVV



PAY THE HIGHER EDUCATION STUDENT'S HEALTHCARE FEE TO KELA

The student healthcare fee is also paid through OmaKela, and it must be paid by November 15, 2026. No separate invoice will be sent to your home or electronically



REGISTER AS PRESENT AND ACTIVATE YOUR LUT CREDENTIALS BEFORE THE FRESHER WEEK

You can register as present through Oili (<https://oili.csc.fi/>). With your LUT credentials, you'll get access to your student card and be able to log into your school email and platforms like Moodle

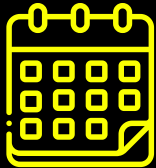

DOWNLOAD YOUR STUDENT CARD

PREPARE CASH AND/OR DOWNLOAD MOBILEPAY AND KIDE.APP

In most student events, the only accepted payment methods are MobilePay or kide.app, so if you haven't downloaded them yet, make sure to do so now. Sometimes you can also pay with cash so make sure you have some on you as well.



TAKE SOME FORMAL WEAR WITH YOU

On Thursday, August 28th, the Suit Up party will take place, with a cocktail dress code. If possible, pack an outfit that fits the dress code for the fresher weeks. Dress codes will be rehearsed later.

IF YOU WANT TO DRINK BEVERAGES – BUY THEM BEFOREHAND

If you think thirst might catch you off guard during Fresher Weeks, it's a good idea to get your starter drinks in advance. The Fresher Weeks' schedule is busy, and everyone else will also be thinking about buying their drinks from the University's Sale, but its shelves will be empty before you know it. Having an emergency frozen pizza on hand wouldn't hurt either.



TRAVELLING

PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION - JOUKO

Buses are often the most convenient way to get around Lappeenranta – though a small downside is that they run poorly at night.

You can get a bus card with a student discount from the Aalef kiosk at the university, making travel significantly cheaper. The card can be charged with either value or time.

A mobile ticket can also be purchased through an app at the regular adult fare. Singular tickets can also be purchased on the bus with your card.



PAYIQ

Don't be surprised if your ticket price varies – buses use off-peak fares on weekends, public holidays, and on weekdays after 5:30 PM, making tickets slightly cheaper than usual.

ADDITIONALLY...



ELECTRIC SCOOTERS- AND CITY BIKES

Always a good choice – except when drunk or when there are two on board.



TAXI

In Lappeenranta, you can order a taxi through Taksisaimaa or the 02Taksi service. When booking a taxi, it's a good idea to share a ride with fellow students. Fortunately, Uber is also gradually starting to make an appearance here!



BY WALKING OR BY BIKE

Your legs, your own bike, or Donkey Republic's city bikes will take you efficiently from one place to another, regardless of the time of day.

CAMPUS'S RESTAURANTS

Bistro – A little further from the LOAS office. The furthest one, the 'office cafeteria'.

YOLO – As the name suggests, it is located at the student union building, and you can get refills!

LUT Buffet – In the main building, the school cafeteria.

Cafe Shalik – Indian food next to auditorium 2310.

Street Cafe – Coffee, pastries, energy drinks.

Restaurant Skinnarila – Usually the same food as in the Buffet, but located in the AMK facilities.

Cafe Shalik Pizza buffet – Located in building number 6

In the school cafeterias, students can get a lunch for €3,10 by showing their student card. You can also buy snacks at the university's Sale or Street Cafe



DRESS CODE

AKA HOW TO DRESS

SMART CASUAL

Smart Casual is typically worn for events such as company visits and case nights, where a neat appearance is expected. It is often considered similar to Business Casual, making it suitable for office wear.

For a Smart Casual event, you can wear neat jeans with a collared shirt and possibly a relaxed blazer, dress pants with a more informal top, a pencil skirt with a relaxed top, or trousers paired with a stylish blouse and a blazer.



COCKTAIL

Cocktail attire largely depends on the nature of the event. The safest choice is a suit or a knee-length dress, paired with a blazer, bolero, or shawl if needed for shoulder coverage.

For formal occasions, a dark suit, white shirt, and a subtle tie are recommended. In more relaxed settings, a colored shirt and a playful tie can be suitable.

For the Suit Up party during Fresher Weeks, a dress, or smart trousers with a collared shirt, would be a great choice.



HOKINAIT

Hokinait is a commonly used but unofficial dress code in Skinnarila, suited for festive yet casual occasions—despite having nothing to do with ice hockey.

It falls between smart casual and cocktail attire, meaning appropriate outfit choices include neat jeans or a little black dress (which can also be in other colors), or a skirt paired with a slightly more festive top. These can be complemented with a casual blazer or a stylish cardigan (so no hockey jerseys :D).



DRESS CODE

AKA HOW TO DRESS



OVERALLS

The easiest and most common dress code. Until freshers get their overalls, they can simply wear regular clothes instead.

Overalls should not be worn just anywhere—they are only appropriate when the dress code specifically states "overalls." If you're unsure whether overalls are expected for an event, it's safer to wear regular clothes instead.

Overalls can also be combined with themed outfits, for example, when the dress code is "Overalls + Afterski." In this case, you wear your overalls along with other theme-appropriate clothing.

BLACK TIE / WHITE TIE

This dress code is primarily seen in academic annual celebrations (vuju) in Skinnarila.

For these events, attire is either white tie or a full-length evening gown. A white tie ensemble consists of a tailcoat with matching trousers that have a silk stripe on the side, a white tailcoat shirt, a white vest, and a white bow tie. The outfit is completed with cufflinks, patent leather shoes, and suspenders instead of a belt. If desired, a pocket watch can also be worn. As an alternative, a dark suit can replace the tailcoat.

For those opting for a full-length evening gown, the dress should cover the ankles. If the dress has an open back or shoulders, a bolero, stole, or shawl should be worn. The fabric is typically formal and elegant, and statement jewelry is acceptable. A small evening clutch is used as an accessory.

Academic honors, ribbons, and guild sashes can be worn to signify which organization or student association the attendee represents.

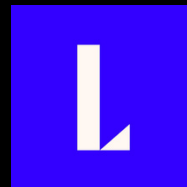
