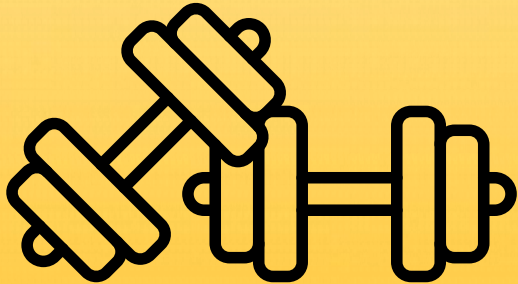
MOVEO

Lanu Park was created between 1989 and 1992, when the City of Lahti commissioned artist Olavi Lanu to create 12 sculptures for the forest of Kariniemenmäki. The sculptures blend seamlessly into the natural surroundings and are based on Lanu's 1978 Venice Biennale installation, Life in Finnish Forests, which explores the relationship between humans and nature.

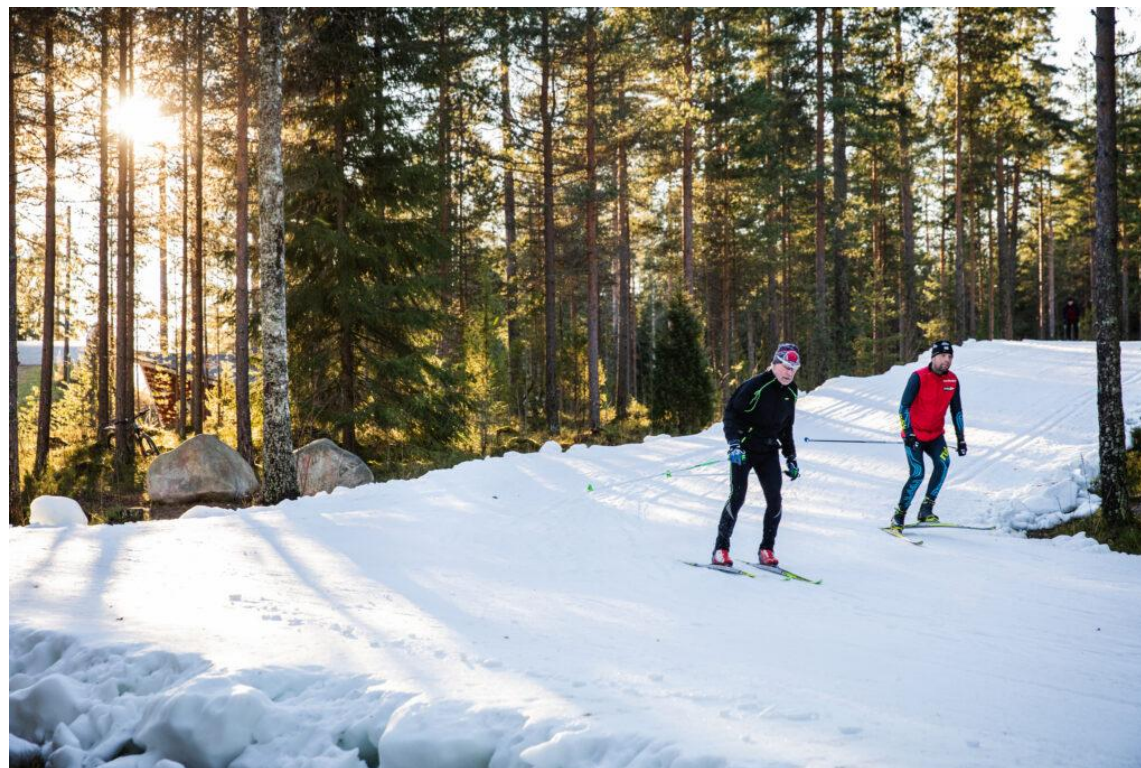
